For the student's assistance, paragraph numbers of appropriate sections of the *Catechism* are indicated in brackets (Example: [CCC §15-55]) and the appropriate document of the *Vatican Council II* are indicated in *italics* (Example: *Lumen Gentium*). NOTE: Students do not need to cover the readings in the *Catechism* in their monthly papers.

Students need to read all texts before class in order to fully participate in class discussion and group work as well as use the text readings in preparing sections of the monthly integration and instructor's group review sessions.
